## Implementation Structure Discussion:

Brett presented on the implementation of the 1W1P and the difference between agreement vs Joint Powers entity. Ping Pong Ball Example.

#### 3 Basic Implementation for 1W1P

- Individual Grant Agreements
  - o The grant dollars are divided amongst all entities. All entities have our own grant agreement and workplan with BWSR. Money cannot be shared or is difficult to do so.
  - o Not recommended by BWSR and no other watershed has done it.
- MOA for Implementation (Collaboration)
  - Very similar to how we are operating now. We work as a group on the work plan. We need a policy committee, fiscal agent, and coordinator. We work together, money can be moved around as needed with work plan revision.
  - o This is how majority of the plans operate and is how it was intended to be.
- Joint Powers Board
  - New entity/level of government. Only as strong as your weakest link, in this case, SWCD's have the most restrictive operations, i.e., no tax authority. A delegate from each individual board is selected and this delegate has decision making power on this new board. The JPB board has final say. Individual boards would have no say.
  - Must have its own bank account and insurance.

### **Next Steps:**

- Internal review: comments received and handled. Usually lots of comments
- 60-day formal review: too all state and federal agencies
- 14 days after the formal review you are required to hold a public hearing, hopefully for November.

After the hearing all entities will go to their boards to approve supporting the plan.
