

The Sand Hill River Watershed Board of Managers met July 6, 1976 at the Roland Gullekson home. Members present - Olson, Gullekson, Wilkens. Absent - LaVoi, Larson. We spent the majority of the time working on the overall plan.

The Department of Natural Resources sent us a copy of a permit to deepen a channel between Union Lake and a smaller pot hole to facilitate the migration of fish for spawning and provide a channel back to the main lake to prevent winter kill. The board had no objection to this permit and decided no action was necessary.

The Polk County Farmers Union Association, Loren Stortroen president, applied for a permit to apply sand to a beach on Lake Sarah in front of their property. The board, having no objections to this, decided no action was necessary.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
