- 7. Texas Crossing-Sand Hill Rivers

- 8. Weed control in Sand Hill Ditch.

 Stanley Roningen reported Leafy Spurge growing on both sides of the river channel east of Burd bridge between sections 14 and 23 of Hubbard Twp. Exec Secretary was authorized to notify the County Weed Inspector and have the County weed Inspector order spraying if necessary.

- 10. E.I.S. Winger Flood Control Dam on Trunk Highway # 59.

The meeting will cover the adequacy of the study. People will be an opportunity to comment on the study. No new issues will be brought up. - LI. Garden Twp road, Ditch 17-2 and Garden Slough drainage.
