

SANDHILL RIVER WATERSHED DISTRICT

March 25, 1950

The Board of Directors of the Sand Hill River Drainage and Conservancy District met at Beltrami, Minnesota, on March 25, 1950.

The president, Ole G. Olson, called the meeting to order. All directors were present and others present were: Members of the town board of Hubbard, Scandia, and Liberty. Adolph Skyberg, Ed Ellinger, and L. Giese of the County Board of Polk County were present. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read.

The president then called on M.M. Nygaard, Polk County Engineer, to explain the construction of the present bridges in the above mentioned township. Some of the bridges, Mr. Nygaard stated, were in need of repair and some of the bridges would have to be rebuilt because there were too small.
