July 5, 1983

1. Roland Gullekson, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 8:00 PM. Board members also present were: Daniel Wilkens, Secretary; Vernon Larson, Treasurer; Francis LaVoi and Conrad Carlson, Exec Secretary.
2. The next regular meeting was set for August 2, 1983 at 8:00 PM.
3. Other people present were: Gale Fraser, Houston Engineering, and Danny Grunhovd.
4. The minutes of the June 7, 1983 meeting were approved as amended.
5. The Treasurer's report was approved as read.
6. Lower Red River Tour:
Report by Roland Gullekson and Gale Fraser on Red Lake Watershed projects.
7. Sandhill River – Highway #59 Dam Project.
Possible funding by Army Corps of Engineers as a small Flood Control project. The Army Corps of Engineers would first have to do some preliminary planning, then do an Economic feasibility study. Francis LaVoi moved that the Sandhill Board submit a resolution to the Army Corps of Engineers that the Sandhill River and Highway #59 Dam project be approved by the Army Corps of Engineers. Daniel Wilkens seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. (Copy of Resolution in Secretary minutes Book).
8. Lower Red River Watershed Meeting July 13th and 14th.
Will observe the effect of water of the Red River and effect on Canadian side of Boarder. There will also be a review and evaluation of the McCombs-Knutson water study.
9. Project #1. Beaver Dams.

10. Permit Approved:

Permit #1983-17 approved to Danny Grundhovd. Sec 16 Bear Park Twp to construct a grassed waterway to constructed under direction of Soil Conservation Service.
